Wrong Message

- ▶ Terrible pests, such as Aphids, Bud Worms, JAPANESE BEETLES! Deer!
- Get hurt by hot sun, Freezing weather, No rain, too much rain

- ► Google and see what comes up!


Growing Roses= Getting Stuck by Thorns



HOW NOT TO GET STUCK BY THORNS

Thorns do not attack rosarians

Rosarians attack thorns





AVOID GETTING STUCK

APPROACH THORNS FROM ABOVE GOING DOWNWARDS NEVER GO UPWARDS TOWARDS THE THORNS

HOW TO AVOID GETTING STUCK

- CUT SMALL PARTS EACH TIME
- CUT FROM OUTSIDE TO INSIDE
- CUT FROM TOP TO BOTTOM
- START CLEARING THE CENTER ONLY AFTER REDUCING THE SIZE OF THE BUSH



LOPPERS

GATHERING PRUNED WASTE

PLACE EACH STEM AND CANE DIRECTLY INTO WHEEL BARROW

- NEVER DROP CUTTINGS ON THE GROUND
- DON'T GIVE THE THORNS A SECOND OPPORTUNITY OR MORE ENCOUNTERS TO STICK YOU!

WHEN EXACTLY TO PRUNE?

- ► EARLY WINTER ANY TIME AFTER FOLIAGE FALLS OFF
- ► EARLY SPRING-BEFORE DORMANCY BREAKS
- ▶ NEW GROWTH CONSUMES A LOT OF STORED ENERGY
- ▶ DO NOT WAIT FOR FORCYTHIA TO BLOOM OR ANYTHING ELSE!




HOW TO AVOID PRUNING SHOCK

- ▶ WHEN DO PLANTS GO INTO PRUNING SHOCK?
- ► AFTER PRUNING IN THE SUMMER FOR FALL SHOWS
- ► WHAT CAUSES SHOCK?
- LOSS OF FOLIAGE


HOW TO AVOID PRUNING SHOCK


MINIMIZE FOLIAGE LOSS CUT NO MORE THAN A THIRD OFF DO NOT CUT BEYOND THE LATEST BLOOMED STEM






First Blooming Cycle






SECOND BLOOMING CYCLE

BANANA TREE

- WHY BANANA TREE?
- WHY IS THIS NOT PRODUCING BANANAS?
- NEED 18 FULL LEAVES TO PRODUCE A BUNCH





MATURING PROCESS FOR PLANTS

- ► TOMATOES
- ► PEPPERS
- ► WON'T PRODUCE UNTIL THEY MATURE!
- BUILDING FOOD-MANUFACTURING FACTORIES
- ► FOLIAGE BUILDING!

SACRIFICING FLOWER BUDS

- ► 50 -60% BUDS ARE SACRIFICED
- ► NOT SPOKEN OF VERY MUCH!
- ► ENERGY IS RE-DIRECTED TO REMAINING BUDS
- CAN'T ALWAYS PREDICT WHICH BUDS ARE GOING TO BLOOM TO BECOME QUEENS!

Take home message

- ▶ BE MINDFUL OF THORNS
- ► CAN GROW ROSES WITHOUT GETTING STUCK
- ► GETTING STUCK BY THORNS IS NOT AN ESSENTIAL PART OF GROWING ROSES
